Survey Methodology



Civiqs polled 1936 young people age 17-39 nationwide from January 2-6, 2022.

The survey was conducted online, among selected members of the Civiqs research panel.

Survey results are weighted by age, gender, race, education, and party identification. Respondents include an oversample of Asian-Americans and Pacific Islanders (AAPI) to increase the precision of survey results for that subgroup. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 2.5\%$.










Generally speaking, which of these best describes your feelings about politicians in Washington, DC today?






Sentiments about State & Local Government, by Party







Positive Impact of Biden Administration, by Party










Politicians' Priority by Age Group, by Party






Politicians' Priority by Age Group, by Age













Joe Biden Favorable Rating, by Party






Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Joe Biden?



















Democrats in Congress Favorable Rating, by Race





Republicans in Congress Favorable Rating, by Party




Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Republicans in Congress?





Opinion of Democrats in Congress, by Party




Has your opinion of Democrats in Congress changed since they won control of the U.S. House and Senate in the 2020 elections?





Expand early voting (ability to vote before Election Day)	8%




Pausing Student Loan Repayment, by Age






Pausing Student Loan Repayment, by Race




What comes closest to your views on actions the Biden Administration should take regarding student loan debt?



Biden Administration - Student Loan Debt, by Race






Global Climate Change, by Urbanicity






Availability of Abortion Services, by Party






Availability of Abortion Services, by Age






Availability of Abortion Services, by Race









What do you think is the best way to get politicians to do more to benefit young people in America?








Which source do you trust most to get information about upcoming elections, candidates and issues you care about?


